

The Delmenhorst Dancie

A reel for three couples in a four-couple longwise set

BARS	DESCRIPTION
1–2	1st couple set to each other.
3–8	1st couple, giving right hands, cross over, cast off one place and, giving left hands, turn once round to finish in second place on opposite sides facing out.
9–16	1st couple dance reels of three with corners, giving right shoulder to first corner to begin. 1st man finishes in the middle of the set in 1st place, 1st woman in the middle of the set in 3rd place.
17–20	1st couple, giving right hands, cross up and down and cast to the right around their partner's second corner's place while 2nd and 3rd couples set diagonally across the set and dance right hands across half-way.
21–24	1st couple, giving left hands, turn one and a half times round to finish facing first corners while 2nd and 3rd couples chase clockwise half-way round the set to places.
25–32	1st couple turn first corners by the right hand, partner by the left, second corners by the right and, giving left hands, cross over to 2nd place on own sides.
	Repeat, having passed a couple.
